## A message from Pastor Eric Sayler regarding this Sabbath

When I was a young boy my class went on a field trip. Near my home town of Tillamook was a harbor where a replica of a 16th century sailing ship was docked and giving tours to school groups.

As I walked across the gangplank onto the wooden deck of the ship we were transported back into history, to a time of wind power, fabric sails, and wooden rudders.

One of the things the tour guide explained to us was navigation.

There were several ways that ancient mariners could find their way: a knowledge of the stars and using a sextant were two. One ancient one that he mentioned made use of tension.

Fill a bowl, cup, or other receptacle with water, take a thin length of wire or a needle, rub it on a piece of wool, and set it on the water and it will float!

Water molecules are electromagnetically attracted to each other so they have what's called "water tension." You've seen this phenomenon when you've over-filled a glass yet it hasn't spilled over.

A needle can float on the water tension and not sink, and in this position with the reduced friction it can align with the magnetic poles giving ancient mariners an indication of north, south, east, and west.

This Sabbath we are spending a second week discussing Jesus' Beatitude: Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called children of God. (Mt 5:9)

Sometimes our relationships have tension, what should we do in this situations?

I hope you can join us as we study this important topic.

#### **More Recommendations from ACS for Coronavirus Situation**

- As COVID-19 (coronavirus) continues to expand, please remember that Emergency Management recommends all citizens be "Two-Weeks Ready." Let preparation be the alternative to stress or panic. Two-Weeks Ready includes keeping on hand sufficient food, water, and prescriptions for two weeks. For those without the internet here is the list:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
- Follow CDC's recommendations for using a facemask.
- OCDC does not recommend that people who are well wear a facemask to protect themselves from respiratory diseases, including COVID-19.
- Facemasks should be used by people who show symptoms of COVID-19 to help prevent the spread of the disease to others. The use of facemasks is also crucial for health workers and people who are taking care of someone in close settings (at home or in a health care facility).
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.


