Psalm 23:4

Almost eight years ago Josh and I went on a backpacking trip with some friends. As I prepared I went through my list: water purifier, sleeping bag, food, stove, tent, fishing pole and flies, first aid kit, etc.

We arrived at the trailhead midafternoon and began to hike. The trail started at the bottom of a canyon and led directly up the hillside. Switchback after switchback we trudged on, crossing a small stream many times as we wound our way up the grade.

As the day drew to a close we still had several miles left to travel so we all reached into our packs for headlamps, flashlights, etc.

This is when I realized that I had left one very important item off my list: a light.

As twilight faded I was having a hard time picking my way through the rocks. Everyone else was doing fine. They, including my son, had remembered a flashlight!

Finally, as darkness fully overtook us one of my friends took pity on me and handed me a light. It made all the difference!

All of us go through dark times in life. David talks about this in Psalm 23, “Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death...”

This Easter Sabbath we will be reflecting on that verse while we talk about the One who journeyed through a real valley of the shadow of death before us, Jesus our Savior.

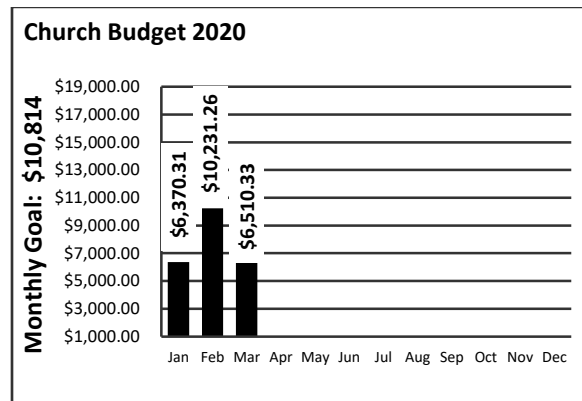

Christian Record Services Offering – April 11

How much is your sight worth? A few years ago, Claudia was talking with Roger, a recently baptized Adventist teenager, about disabilities. Roger was in awe of how Claudia was able to get around, read, and function with a severe disability that drastically reduced her sight. Claudia had lost her eyesight 10 ten years prior and was totally blind. She was studying to become a Seventh-day Adventist Christian and was reading several publications that were provided by Christian Record Services.

After Roger left Claudia’s home, he decided to put a bandana on his eyes and try to function without his eyesight for an entire day. He tried memorizing the placement of furniture, dishes, and other essentials in his room. He only lasted for one hour. Roger kept bumping into things in his house, could not find anything, and felt frustrated. He took off his bandana and understood how important it is to have eyesight and be able to function.

Christian Record Services is an organization that provides materials and services for the visually impaired. It also provides camps for children who are blind and cannot afford to attend them. Our monetary gifts on behalf of Christian Record Services bring us closer to Jesus and also fulfill the commission described in Matthew 28:18-20.

Invitation to UCC Easter Communion Service

Join the Upper Columbia Conference of Seventh-day Adventists for a special Easter Communion Service following church worship on Sabbath, April 11, starting at 12:15 p.m. (Pacific Standard Time). All are welcome!

Upper Columbia Conference (posted Thursday 4/9/2020 on Facebook)

We are experiencing a challenge with our network server. Because of these challenges, we will be moving our online communion event to Facebook live only.

We are including our preparation steps below. Again, we would love to have you join us for this communion service on Sabbath, April 11, at 12:15 p.m. at www.facebook.com/uppercolumbia/

To prepare for this online event, please follow the steps below.

- Read John 13 and Desire of Ages, pages 642 – 661. If possible, please conduct the ordinance of humility in your home.
- Prepare the bread and the wine
- Neither the wine nor the bread contained elements of fermentation because on the evening of the first day of the Hebrew Passover all leaven, or fermentation, had been removed from their dwellings (Ex. 12:15, 19; 13:7). Therefore, only unfermented grape juice and unleavened bread are appropriate for use in the communion service, and great care must be exercised in providing these elements.
- Remember, this is a time of Celebration—Communion should always be a solemn, never somber, experience. Wrongs have been righted, sins have been forgiven, and faith has been reaffirmed. It is a time for celebration!

Communion Bread Recipe

1/2 cup fine-ground flour (preferably whole grain)

1/8 teaspoon salt

1 tablespoons cold water

1/8 cup olive or other vegetable oil

Sift the flour and salt together.

Pour the water into the oil, but do not stir.

Add to the dry ingredients and mix with a fork until all the flour is dampened.

Roll out between two sheets of waxed paper to the thickness of thick pie pastry.

Place on an ungreased, floured baking sheet, and mark off with a sharp knife into squares, being careful to prick each square to prevent blistering.

Bake at 450 for 10 to 12 minutes. Watch carefully during the last five minutes so that the bread will not burn.

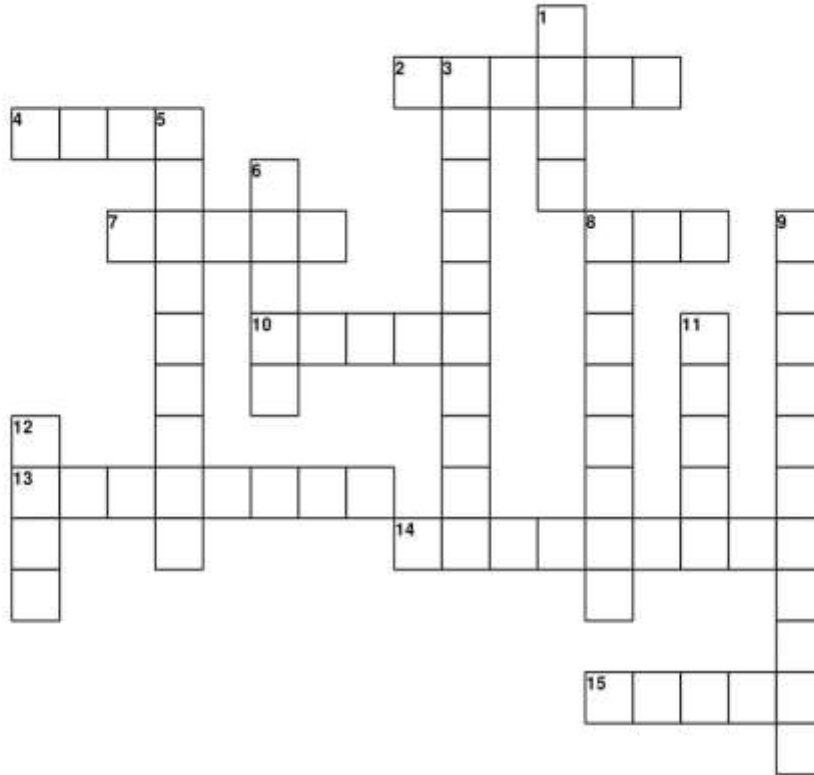
