### Eastgate SDA Church Happenings!!

#### **Up-date on Asher Peterson (second posting)**

After many extra months of waiting, Asher is now moving to the next phase of his treatment! Back in January, Asher's medical team started a national search for a stem cell (bone marrow) donor to treat his Aplastic Anemia. Thanks to bethematch.org and a multitude of donors in their registry, we did not have any trouble finding a suitable match and a donor was identified in less than two months. Unfortunately, while the doctors were working out the logistical details for him to come to Seattle to prepare for the transplant in late March, the world changed. With Covid-19 cases ramping up quickly, it was too risky to start this treatment and leave Asher with no immunity so close to what was at the time the most severe outbreak of this disease in the western hemisphere. As testing capacity has now significantly improved and the spread of the disease has slowed, his doctors now feel that it is time. We received a call a few days ago that he has been scheduled to arrive for his appointment in Seattle next week on May 21st.

Between prepping for the transplant, the procedure itself, and monitoring afterwards, we will be in Seattle for four months. We always appreciate hearing that people are praying for us, and ask for extra prayer that the treatment process will be smooth and completely successful. We could also use an extra helping of God's peace in this time of stress on our family.

For those who are wondering what they can do, here are some easy ways to help other patients who may be experiencing illnesses similar to Asher's:




## <u>School News</u>

The first "13th Sabbath Offering Project was introduced in 1912 to establish a mission in India. With approximately four hundred 13th Sabbaths since that first project, this offering has allowed the church to build schools, dormitories, hospitals, clinics, churches, mission-launches, lambshelters, printing presses and universities around the world. Often there is more than one project for an offering so there have been over a thousand projects. Because tithe money is not allowed to be used for buildings, the 13th Sabbath offering has usually been for construction-type projects.

This quarter's offering will benefit the Trans-European Division in three ways: open a center of influence in Norway, establish a church in Serbia and construct a church and center of influence in Cyprus (refer to the map on the back of the Adult Quarterly).




