One of the most poignant modern songs is one by the band U2.

Bono, the lead singer, a follower of Jesus, has a gift for putting words together in a way that strikes the heart.

In their song “I Still Haven’t Found What I’m Looking For” Bono takes us down a journey of searching. He describes how he’s looked in many places and experiences for ultimate meaning and satisfaction but always came up unfulfilled.

Finally, at the end of the song he has these lyrics:

“I believe in the Kingdom come
Then all the colors will bleed into one
Bleed into one
But yes, I’m still running
You broke the bonds
And you loosened the chains
Carried the cross of my shame, of my shame
You know I believe it”

Yes! Bono has been searching, and he has found!

But then he returns the refrain:

“But I still haven’t found what I’m looking for”

Make of it what you will, art can be interpreted in many ways. Bono has obviously found meaning in Christ but he makes it clear that there’s more to be looking for.

And we would agree. Whether this is what Bono meant or not I think we can take this away: We have found Christ, but there’s more to come. There’s more to look forward to.

Dear church family,

What an odd time we've been living in over the past few months.

In the midst of this there are some good things still happening. We, as a church, are still the church. We are still worshipping, we are still serving, we are still praying, we are still evangelizing.

Over the past month and a half we have intentionally reached out to our community through the Hope Awakens series. Not because we just needed something more to do, but because Christ commands us to and because we love those who need Jesus.

But we're facing a challenge. Maybe because life is different, maybe because some jobs are impacted, maybe because we're not gathering on Sabbath morning, the financial status of the Eastgate church is looking weaker. Over the years you have been faithful, and I thank you for that. But now we need to pull together. In order to continue to share the gospel we, as a church family, need to prayerfully consider how we each can support the Great Commission that Christ has given us. Sharing the gospel requires resources, and resources require funding.

We as a church this past January voted a budget that covers the essential ministries and services that we as a church value. Our monthly goal is \$10,814. So far this year our average has been \$7,362. In addition to this we, as a group, committed to supporting students attending our Adventist schools and we voted to raise funds for needed repairs on God's building.

Now, we as your church leadership are doing everything we can to pinch every penny. We've turned off thermostats, keep lights off, open windows instead of activating AC, all so we can continue to reach the lost. But this only goes so far.

We, as a church, are a family and families pull together. I invite you to consider how you might support the mission of this family to Make and Grow Disciples for Jesus.

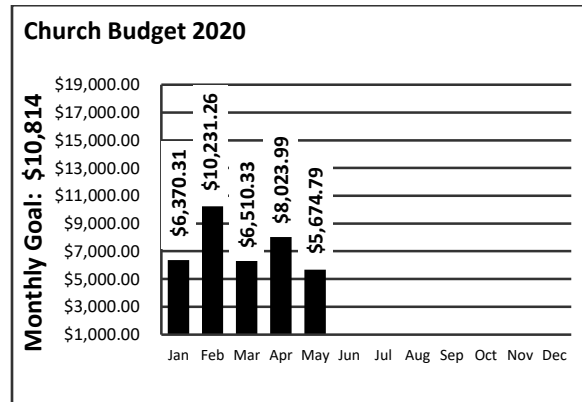

Dear Eastgate Church family:

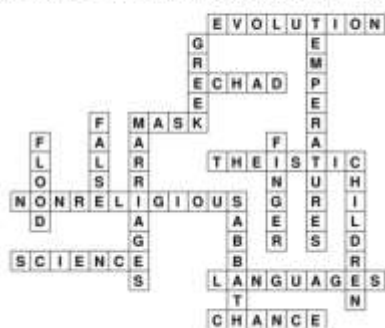

The first “13th Sabbath Offering Project was introduced in 1912 to establish a mission in India. With approximately four hundred 13th Sabbaths since that first project, this offering has allowed the church to build schools, dormitories, hospitals, clinics, churches, mission-launches, lamb-shelters, printing presses and universities around the world. Often there is more than one project for an offering so there have been over a thousand projects. Because tithe money is not allowed to be used for buildings, the 13th Sabbath offering has usually been for construction-type projects.

This quarter’s offering will benefit the Trans-European Division in three ways: open a center of influence in Norway, establish a church in Serbia and construct a church and center of influence in Cyprus (refer to the map on the back of the Adult Quarterly).

You can give a Thirteenth Sabbath Offering any time throughout the quarter by marking your tithe envelope.

Virtual Camp Meeting Coming this Summer!

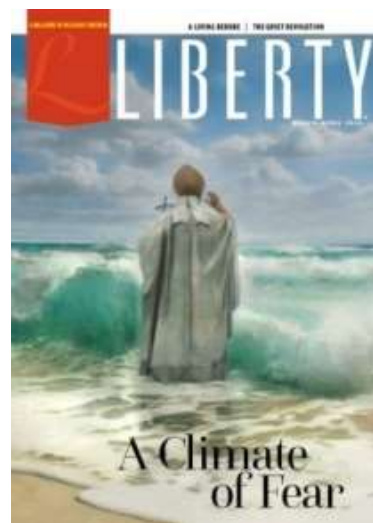
Oregon Conference Information for Happy Rock!!

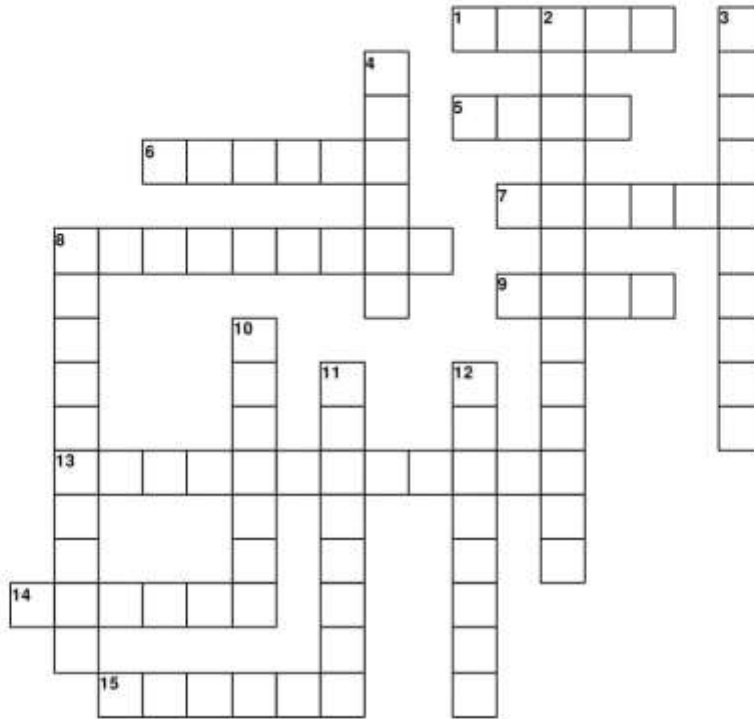
