First, a bit of background:

Goldens, having been bread to retrieve birds while hunting, love to carry things around in their mouths and more often than not bring said objects to us to show them off. They do this because it's been bred into them. They're retrievers.

A second piece of background:

When we moved into our home we used river rock in our flower beds. At first it looked nice but we soon realized that we needed to remove it because one of our other Goldens, Sophia, swallowed a rock. Not good! Because of this we have removed nearly every river rock from the back yard and the only ones left are the random scattered stones that we missed here and there.

On this particular evening Winston decided that he was going to help us clean up the rocks! As we watched he would wander across the yard till he found a little stone, gingerly pick it up, and proudly bring it to us, often dropping it at our feet!

He did this over and over till there was a pile of at least twenty rocks that he collected for us!

Obviously he didn't do this because he cared about our landscaping, he did it because he's a retriever. He was simply being true to who he was made to be.

You could say he had integrity. He was living according to his design.

This Sabbath we are starting a new sermon series on the book of Daniel. As we explore Daniel's historical context and as we look at chapter 1 we will see how Daniel, too, lived a life of integrity, living as God had designed *him* to live.

Up-date on Asher Peterson

Asher received his stem cell transplant last week. During the transplant he had a severe reaction and ended up in the ICU to control his high blood pressure. I know many of you prayed for us as we were going through this, and your prayers were answered. We were very blessed that he responded quickly to the medications they gave him, and, after a good night's sleep, was able to move back to his regular room in the cancer care unit.

At this point we are playing the waiting game. His immune system counts are at zero, as expected. We await the time his numbers start increasing which indicates "engraftment" of the new stem cells. Prayers are appreciated for swift engraftment, for protection from germs while his body has no means to fight them, and for relief from the side effects of his conditioning






