A message from Elder Carol Hargreaves

Has this current pandemic been a great trial to you or have you settled into a new routine. Do things upset you or have you kept your faith and trust in God vibrant and growing by spending time with Jesus, and sharing His love with others?

In our time together Sabbath morning we will be considering Daniel 3 which is an interesting story about 3 Jewish men who were government officials in Babylon. Does their story have any bearing on what is happening today? Or is it just a fun story to tell the children. I believe there are lessons we can learn, principle that we can take as our own, that will keep us as faithful to God as they were.

When you have been doing what you felt God had called you to do and someone complained about your work - or even worse enlisted others against you, what did you do? How did you act, or react?

At one of the places where I taught church school, things weren't going well. Oh, the children still loved me, but some the parents didn't. One afternoon I was walking on a country road near town and praying. I guess the prayer was more of a complaint about the way I felt I was being treated, and why wasn't God stepping in to help me and make the situation better.

God got my attention with this thought that suddenly came. "Remember Job." That was all He said, but it quickly got me to thinking and reminded me that we are in a warfare that is unseen. We don't know the whole story, or how God will use a situation to grow us. He has plans for us of which we know nothing. Job trusted God even tho' his life seemed ruined. All his possessions had been stolen or burned, his children were dead, he was sick and miserable, and his wife told him to curse God and die. He said, "Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him."

The three men in Babylon told the king he could do anything he wanted, but their trust was in God. We also need to develop the same kind of trust that those three men had, who were thrown bound into the furnace, but walked out free. We also can walk free with God, when we surrender everything to Him.

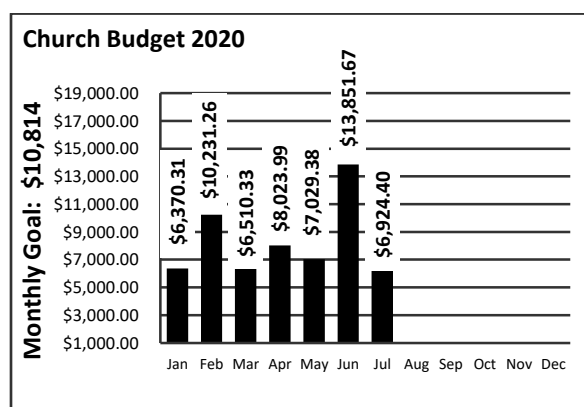

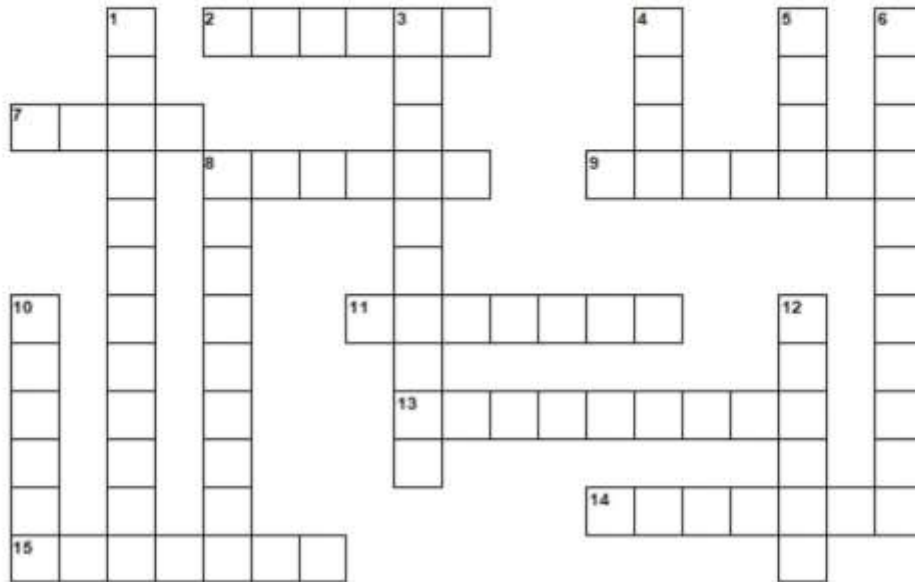
