Scripture has had a huge impact on our society. This impact is larger than most people recognize.

Turns of phrase that are a part of everyday life go unnoticed by many, here are a few: Blind leading the blind (Mt 15), skin of your teeth (Job 19:20), drop in the bucket (Is 40:15), fly in the ointment (Ecclesiastes 10:1), skin and bones (Job 19:19, 20), and a wolf in sheep's clothing (Mt 7:15) to name just a few.

One phrase that is often used is "Writing on the Wall." This phrase comes from Daniel chapter five, which we will be studying this Sabbath. It is used to describe something as plain, obvious, clear, unmistakable, and unambiguous.

The problem with this usage, however, was that in Daniel's story the *Writing on the Wall* was anything but plain. Its meaning was confusing, concerning, and hidden.



Report From Facilities Committee

In January the church had a business meeting where a budget for the current year was proposed and voted on by the members in attendance that evening. A Church Budget was voted on and approved. In addition to the Church Budget, a proposal for Maintenance items here at the church for the 2020 calendar year was presented. Based on the recommendations at the time those in attendance approved a goal of raising \$14,000 to complete several projects throughout the year. These projects have included:

- A Pump House to protect the irrigation pump and reduce maintenance time required.
- A replacement door for the Lawn Mower Storage area {due to vandalism & break-in}
- A replacement door for the Garage. {due to vandalism & break-in}
- A repair to the large garage roll-up door
- Improvements and up-grades to the exterior lighting of the building and parking lot to improve safety and energy efficiency. {This one is still in process; we hope to be completed with this one by the end of September.}

Of this \$14,000 goal we have received contributions as indicated above. If you can help with this process, aside from our regular church budget items, your contributions will be used to maintain a safe and secure facility for use by our church family. Thank you!


