Impact Hope works to rescue youth from Congolese refugee camps in Rwanda by educating them into self-sufficiency at safe schools.

The Situation...

In 1994, all hell broke loose in Rwanda. One million people died in 100 bloody days known as "The Genocide". 26 years later, we have a thriving, young Rwanda, but the aftermath of the genocide still remains. Spilling over into neighboring D.R. Congo, conflict and brutal acts continue to this day that have sent hundreds of thousands of people to flee for their lives. Currently, Rwanda hosts ~80,000 Congolese refugees in United Nations camps that have no electricity, no running water, and deplorable conditions. Violence in the camps at night is a serious threat, especially for female youth. Their situation is generationally hopeless.

Our Solution...

Impact Hope rescues and educates young people.

For only \$600 a year, Impact Hope is able to send one of the youth in the Congolese refugee camps to a safe boarding schools, help them graduate with a diploma, and offer a life skill with vocational training. This program provides three meals a day, lodging with their own dry bed, health services, and all their essentials for living at a safe place to learn.

These young people are filled with so much appreciation and joy for this opportunity to break free from despair!



In collaboration with the United Nations and ADRA Rwanda, As of 2020, Impact Hope has sent over 500 girls to boarding school. This

brings the total boarding school students supported by Impact Hope to over 1100! These youth are so happy for this new hope, and their gratitude is immeasurable!
