When I was a Senior in high school my class went on an adventure called "Senior Survival."

The purpose of this three day excursion as to create unity among the students, develop us spiritually, and equip us for wilderness survival.

One of the first challenges we were presented with when we arrived at our camping area was the building of a tent. We weren't given tents from REI or North Face, we were handed a section of heavy black plastic sheeting and some paracord. From this we were instructed how to construct a durable, warm, waterproof shelter that was to be our home for the rest of the week.

The apostle Paul was a tentmaker, too, but I'm sure his finished product looked a lot better than mine did.

This Sabbath we're going to explore Acts 18 where Luke describes how Paul was a tent maker with his fellow believers, Pricilla and Aquila. I hope you can join in!


