### *A message from Pastor Eric Saylor*

Twenty-two years ago I was blessed to go on my first over-seas mission trip in the beautiful country of Kenya. We landed in Nairobi and made our way to a remote area of the Great Rift Valley and there, among the Massai, Lions, and Guinea Hens we began constructing a church where Maasai members could worship.

Because the location was so remote we brought tents along and camped out on the grassy plane, the sounds of African wildlife drifting through the thin walls either lulling to sleep or keeping awake, depending on each person's anxiety level.

The church we built was made from hand-hewn stone blocks that had been brought in on trucks and piled for our use. The aesthetic the rock created was beautiful, but there was one common problem with the block piles: snakes.

It seemed like every other block we picked up had a Puff Adder under it.

Now, I'm not Ophidiophobic (I don't fear snakes) but when I would lift a twenty pound rock and immediately hear a hiss as a short, fat adder coiled in fear it definitely made me take great care to not put my hand where I couldn't see. Not much would ruin a mission trip like a venomous snake bite.

In Acts 27 and 28 Luke writes about Paul going on a mission trip to Rome, but on the way he's shipwrecked on an island where he, too, meets a snake. This Sabbath we'll examine this story to see what we can learn about Paul, God, and our own presuppositions. I hope you can join in!



**OFFERING OF THE DAY ~ June 26, 2021, Upper Columbia Conference Advance**



It started as a normal day, August 5, 2010. Miners went to work in the caverns of northern Chile.

A little later, the cries of alarm sounded. The mineshaft had collapsed. All 33 miners, half a mile down, had no way to escape. A check of the underground emergency shelter revealed only a few days' worth of food rations.

When their plight became known, officials brought a Pennsylvania drilling company. They bored a small shaft to reach the miners. It took 17 days for a new drill to bore a small hole to reach

the men.

During the wait, some men considered suicide an option. But their leader urged that it was better to work and stay busy than to give up in despair.

On August 22, a small shaft reached the men. They sent food, water, and medicine. The rescue crew communicated with the miners, who regained hope.

On October 12, a one-man capsule went down, and the first man returned to the surface. It took 69 days after the collapse tragedy to rescue all 33 miners.

Today our Conference Advance has a rescue plan. The plan is to rescue souls buried not only in sin, but also in the circumstances of life. As we give to Upper Columbia Conference Advance, we are taking part in the rescue of precious souls for Christ.
