Several years ago we got to visit a sheep ranch during lambing time.

As we pulled in and climbed out of our car our ears were filled with both the high-pitched sound of lambs crying and the lower voices of their mothers. Our friend, Juan, who was in charge of the shepherds met us and led us into the long, low barns that housed the birthing sheep.

As we walked down the aisles we saw newborn babies eagerly nursing, little tails waggling back and forth in joy. We saw ewes giving birth and greeting their babies with sweet little sounds.

And then we came to a pen with ten or fifteen lambs who were all alone. It wasn't that they didn't have mamas, they had simply been rejected. They're called "bummer lambs."

The reason of this is unclear: maybe there was a hormone problem, maybe there was a significant distraction at birth, maybe it was a dramatic birth, maybe the lamb didn't smell right, but for whatever reason when these lambs were born their mamas weren't "faithful." They didn't follow through.

Faithfulness isn't just a sheep problem, it's a human one, too. We all struggle with faith and faithfulness at times in our lives.

This Sabbath we're continuing our series on "The Letter to the Hebrews" and exploring the concept of "A community of Faith(fulness)."

I hope you can join for worship as we explore this idea and realize the grace-centered keys to walking faithfully with Jesus!



Perhaps the best-known text in the Old Testament book of Malachi is, "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse." Malachi added God's challenge: "Test me... and see if I will not throw open the floodgates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it" (Mal. 3:10).

Today, some Christians promote the "Prosperity Gospel," which draws on verses like this. Give to God (or my

church or ministry), and God will give you more money than you gave. Forget investing in the stock market or real estate; give your money to God and watch your bank account surge.

While God wanted to illustrate His blessing through material prosperity to the Israelites in Old Testament times, Christ certainly didn't exhibit lots of money. In the New Testament, Paul predicted that those who sowed sparingly would reap sparingly, while those who sowed generously would also reap generously (2 Cor. 9:6). However, Paul further explained that abundance would be in good deeds and righteousness (vv. 8–10).

Have you put God to the test when it comes to blessings? What did you "sow" in the past? What will you "sow" this year? Are you prepared to receive God's blessings, whether they are financial or whether they come in another form—like faith, godliness, joy, fellowship, and love for God and others?

Let's give to God and rely on him to provide the blessings in the forms He chooses and at the time He chooses.
